World War II

Served in Europe as an anti-aircraft gunner. Achieved rank of E-5 Corporal.

Richard W. Bilger

Army

World War II

Served in Germany. Achieved rank of Private First Class.

Kenneth Bixler*

Air Force

World War II

Stationed in France during the war and worked in the Command Center. Achieved rank of Colonel.

Sally Bixler*

Army, 1942 to 1944

World War II

Served as an Army nurse. Achieved rank of 2nd Lieutenant.

Gerald "Jerry" B. Bolig

Coast Guard, 1953 to 1957

Korean War

Two years on a CG Cutter maintaining the ship's store and monthly reports. Served 18 months at U.S. Coast Guard Academy, payroll and various reports. Achieved rank of SK2.

Norman Brabson*

Army, 1953 to 1955

Korean War Era

Served in Germany. Worked with photographic maps.

Achieved rank of S 2|c.

Vietnam Era

Army Reserves, 1970 to 1976

Vietnam Era

Construction engineer. Achieved rank of E-5 Sergeant.

Ed Coursey

Army National Guard, 1972 to 1982

Served in rear area operations. Maryland Army Guard. Achieved rank of Staff Sergeant.

Kenneth "Ken" Cox

Air Force, 1970 to 1971

Vietnam Era

Served as a parachute rigger. Active duty and reserves. Achieved rank of E-3 Airman First Class.

Francis "Fran" Curtis

Army, 1950 to 1953

Korean War

Served as a radar operator and in the infantry. Achieved rank of E-6 Staff Sergeant.

Roger Dean*

Navy, 1957 - 61

Served in engineering, USS Hancock, Pacific theater and naval reserves.

Achieved rank of Lieutenant commander

World War II

World War II

Served as a member of the Navy Hospital Corps. at the U.S. Naval Hospital, Jacksonville (FL). Achieved rank of Pharmacist's Mate Third Class, V-10.

Craig Dietterick

Air Force, 1967 to 1971

Developed training plans and taught courses regarding systems operations for new squadron arrivals. Served at Rhein-Main AFB, Germany, Cannon AFB, NM. Achieved rank of Sergeant.

H. Warren Dimmig*

Navy 1942 to 1946

World War II

Was trained as a flight instructor. After 30 hours of instruction, he then trained pilots for 4 years.

Attended Engineer OCS, Ft. Belvoir (VA), Military Intelligence School, Ft. Holabird (MD), and Special Warfare School, Ft. Bragg (NC). Served as G-2 Security Officer for 2nd Armored Division, Ft. Hood (TX). Achieved rank of 1st Lieutenant.

Richard "Dick" Donavan*

Army National Guard, 1952 to 1960

Korean War

Pennsylvania National Guard. Worked with remote controlled flying drone aircraft. Also worked with Nike Ajax missile system. Was federalized and worked with anti-aircraft guns. Achieved rank of SP-5 Sergeant.

Gregory "Greg" Elko

Army, 2003 to 2009

Second Gulf War

Served in Iraq in 2006 as Ranger, platoon leader, and administrator. Achieved rank of Captain.

James "Jim" Evangelisto

Air Force, 1966 to 1970

Vietnam Conflict

Served in the Philippines as a cryptographic equipment technician. Served on a SAC base in New England. Achieved rank of Sergeant.

Curtis "Curt" A. Federolf*

Army, 1941 to 1945

World War II

A member of the US Army Air Corps, Curt served in the Southwest Pacific and was captured on the Philippine Islands on approximately May 7, 1942. He was held by Imperial Japan on the internment camp Omori Headquarters Camp (Ofuna) and spent 1,175 days in captivity. He died on July 25, 1945 when bombs fell on the Prisoner of War (POW) camp in Japan where he had been held in captivity. Achieved rank of Private First Class.

Korean War

Radar technician. Achieved rank of E-5 Staff Sergeant.

Rudolph Forst

World War II Achieved rank of Sergeant.

He died in action on June 6, 1968, at the age of 19, when his helicopter came under hostile file and crashed on land in Quang Tri Province, South Vietnam. He was posthumously awarded medals, including the Bronze Star, for saving the life of a wounded comrade in a previous action. Achieved rank of Lance Corporal.

Marty Hansen

Vietnam Era

Served as military policeman with duty stations at 57th MP Company, West Point (NY) and 503rd MP Company (Drake Kaserne) Frankfurt (Germany). Duties included building and post security, military alerts, civil disturbances, investigations, and radio operation/vehicle patrols. A draftee who spoke German, he was promoted to E-5 Sergeant after 1.5 years of service. Achieved rank of E-5 Sergeant.

Thomas "Tom" L. Heaton

Served as a translator of Chinese Mandarin for the Army Security Agency. Was based in Okinawa and Taiwan.
