While LDR is currently in the midst of long term recovery for hundreds of Hurricane Ida survivors right here in Montgomery, Delaware, Bucks, Chester, and Philadelphia counties, many still do not have working heat and hot water. Disaster case managers like Ali help families access rental assistance, furniture, and rebuilding and repair resources. While we are beginning to experience the impact of climate change across the Northeast, in the form of wetter, more unpredictable weather, LDR - eastern PA is determined to keep the most vulnerable in the greatest focus as we build new partnerships, change how we do outreach, and most notably by paying attention to those who are renters, a group that has long been overlooked in disaster recovery.
